<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Newspapers / Inserts• Catalogs / Magazines• Envelopes• Junk Mail (No Product Samples like Credit Cards, etc.)• Home Office Paper (Copy and Fax paper - White or pastel, manila envelopes, file folders)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Wax Coated Papers / Boxes (Like Milk / Juice Cartons)• Tissues/ Tissue Paper• Boxboard (Thin cardboard and paperboard like cereal boxes, shoe boxes, beer/pop cartons <u>all go with cardboard</u>)• Food Wrappers• Paper Towels• Soiled or Food Stained Paper• Hard Back Book Bindings• Styrofoam

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clean Pizza Boxes• Cardboard Egg Cartons• Moving / Mailing Boxes• Boxboard and Paperboard (Like Cereal Boxes, Beer / Pop Cartons, Toothpaste or Toiletry Boxes, Paper Towel or Toilet Paper Rolls) are included in cardboard <p>Breakdown ALL Cardboard Boxes.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Paper goes in the paper bin and all cardboard is separate.• Helpful Hint: Some customers prefer to use a large corrugated box to put all their cardboard, boxboard, and paperboard in. <p>Breakdown ALL Cardboard Boxes.</p>

GLASS

- Glass Bottles and Jars
(Clear and Colored - Without caps or tops)

Please rinse jars and bottles - this keeps your bins smelling good and pest free.

- Lightbulbs

- Keep Bins stored indoors until pickup day to preserve their condition.
